Associate Member Requirements:

- 112 units of training in Ortho-Bionomy which includes:
 - 32 units of Phase Four
 - 16 units of Phase Five
 - 16 units of Phase SixThe balance of the units should be from the required classes in the Registered Practitioner Training Program.
- One evaluation session of Ortho-Bionomy given to a Registered Ortho-Bionomy Instructor.

Continuing Education Requirement:

- Associate Members must complete 16 units of continuing education in Ortho-Bionomy annually. A copy of the Certificate of Attendance or other documentation must be included with payment of annual membership fees
